RULES FOR SPORTS

1. ADMISSION AGAINST THE SPORTS SEATS

- (1) The Vice Chancellor shall constitute a separate committee for admission against the sports seats. The committee shall consist of atleast five members.
- (2) One seat is reserved in each of the BS degree programmes of the University.
- (3) All admissions against the sports seats shall be granted to applicants on the basis of prescribed criteria.
- (4) All members of the committee shall award score out of 20 marks and average shall be considered towards the final score.
- (5) The candidates seeking admission on the basis of outstanding performance in sports are required to submit a "Sports Form" along with the usual Admission Form. Candidate applying on Sports Basis will not be considered on Open Merit if he/ she has not submitted a separate Application Form for Open Merit.
- (6) Attested copies of sports certificates must be attached with the form. No sports certificate will be accepted after the due date of submission of the Admission Form.
- (7) Candidates shall have to appear for the trials of the sports according to the programme given by the sports office. The candidates recommended by the Sports Committee will be called for interview on the scheduled dates. Selection of the Sports Committee cannot be challenged. The candidates who remain absent or fail in the trials/ interview shall lose claim to admission. No separate arrangement for trials/ interview will be made by the University in any case.
- (8) Students selected for admission on sports basis will be granted admission by the admission committee in the degree programme on the basis of the candidate's ability and aptitude. The decision of the Admission Committee shall be final.

- (9) Sportspersons are required to actively participate in sports activity and strictly follow the regulations and rules of the University. In case of indiscipline or violation, shall be expelled from the University.
- (10) The University will pay stipend to sportspersons as per rates prescribed for the purpose.
- (11) None of the sportsperson is permitted to play for any department or agency. The sportsperson will get prior permission from the Director Sports if he/ she wants to participate in any sports other than University, otherwise he/ she shall be expelled from the University.
- (12) Relaxation may be granted to sportsperson only on account of sports activities. Non-participant sportsperson is bound to attend regular classes/ examinations.
- (13) The permission of semester freeze may be granted to a sportsperson on account of his/ her sports activities at any stage before the start of mid semester examination. On re-joining, after freeze of the semester, no additional fee will be charged.
- (14) The sportspersons will display human values of highest and mature level during sports activities and competitions.

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7. CODE OF CONDUCT OF THE SPORTSPERSONS

- (1) The following sports code of conduct shall be binding to all University students and staff, officially representing the University in sports competitions or at University sports functions. All members of the University in representative sports teams or acting as team officials shall be bound and shall be informed of the existence of this code.
- (2)Sportspersons and Officials representing the University shall abide by the regulations and rules of the University at all times. Representatives of sports teams shall be expected to respect and abide by the rules of the sports association they affiliate to. Established and laid down procedures for specific sports or competitions shall be followed when disputing decisions by Referees, Track Judges or other Officials. Sportspersons and officials shall not at any time, engage in unbecoming behaviour which could bring University into disrepute. When representing the University, sportspersons and their officials shall not intimidate, threaten, assault or attempt to intimidate or assault a sports official, another participant or a spectator. Sportspersons and their officials shall not use crude, abusive or insulting language or make offensive gestures. Sportspersons shall not abuse the University kit by wearing it other than during official University or league or friendly games or by not returning it to the

- Sports Office at agreed time. All such cases shall attract a disciplinary measure in terms of University rules.
- (3) Sportspersons shall not abuse University equipment by using it for un-authorized events and shall return it promptly to the Sports Office at the agreed time. All missing kit and equipment shall be charged to the account of the person who signed for it from the Sports Office at the current market value.
- (4) Sportspersons and their officials shall not at any time engage in unbecoming behaviour which could bring them, or their sport or University into disrepute. Sportspersons and their officials shall not use or in any way be connected to the use of distribution of illegal drugs. Sportspersons shall abide by the legitimate instructions of the appointed Team Coach, Manager or Chairperson or any such other official appointed by the Director Sports.
- (5) Any person who braches code/ rules shall be liable to be disciplinary action by the University.
