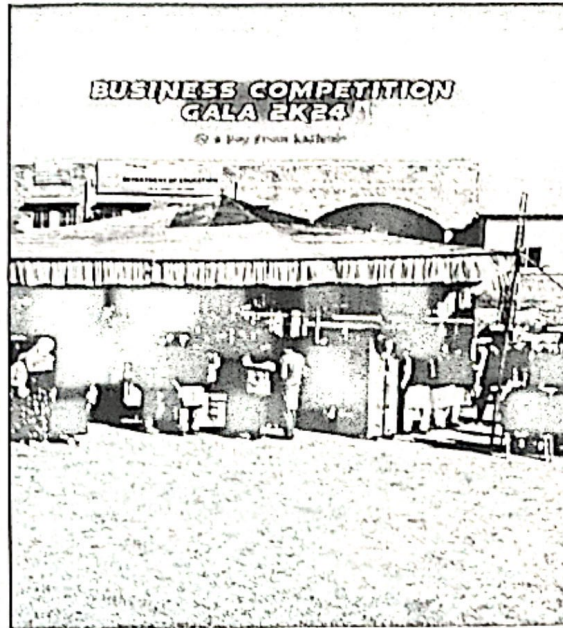
### **Detailed Overview of The Event**

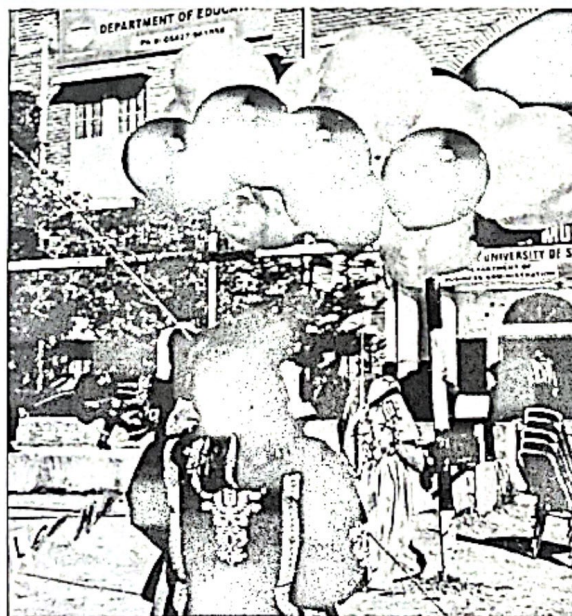
